

Room Notes

Cricket Rooms 1 – 4

The original upper servant's rooms, with a lovely ham stone fireplace in No 2, the rooms are decorated in a Farrow and Ball colour palette of bone, verte de terre, lichen and fowler pink; every room has a pretty Sanderson quilt on the bed

Rose Rooms 5 – 8

Originally divided into male and female dormitories the central room [now used as the children's play area] still retains the handwritten sign on the left hand wall 'No manservant past this door'. Like the Cricket Rooms the Rose Rooms are decorated in a Farrow and Ball colour palette of bone, verte de terre, lichen and fowler pink with a hand blocked wallpaper in the corridors

Tower Rooms 9 – 11

These rooms are situated in the medieval wing of Brympton and are accessed via by a stone turret. They are decorated in earthy tones of tallow, mahogany and Dutch pink

Fane Rooms 12-13

Forming part of the ground floor of the medieval wing these rooms are decorated in a delicious Farrow and Ball palette of hound lemon, joas white and house white

Eleanor 14

On the same corridor as the ballroom this lovely 1680 panelled room is painted in a mixture of Farrow and Ball bone and James white

Home Farm 15 - 20

The medieval home farm of the Brympton estate these rooms are decorated in a soothing Farrow and Ball palette of tallow, pointing, dutch pink and ringwold ground; the beds are decorated with vintage welsh blanket quilts

Information for your Guests!!

The following was prepared by one of my brides [thank you Amy!] and I thought that the information it contained was so useful that it should be copied and be circulated to all:

I thought I'd send some information prior to your stay so that it helps the Wedding Day go as smoothly as possible.

The first thing to note is that we will be the only guests at Brympton and so the weekend will be more like staying in a large country house with friends and family, as opposed to staying in a hotel , which I would remind you Brympton is not.

You can access your room at Brympton at any time from **xxx**. There is no formal 'checking in procedure' because the rooms have already been paid for. The House kindly requests that guests do not arrive before this time because the management not only need to ensure the rooms are ready but also have the wedding to prepare for.

Car parking at Brympton will be in the main car park – please **do not** park in the driveway in the front of the house.

When you arrive you should go to the main entrance (Great Hall) and someone will be able to show you to your room. Please take a moment to look at the table below which tells you which room you've been allocated.

Brympton do not allocate keys for each room as experience has shown that too many get lost and then the cost of replacement goes back to the Bride & Groom. We would therefore suggest that you do not leave your family jewels in the room, although we would again remind you that it is only us staying at the venue.

The Library Bar will be open from **1pm** and you will be able to get a drink prior to the Ceremony should you wish

The Ceremony will be held at **xxx** in the Castle House.

Breakfast will be served in the Star Chamber at **9.30am** in the morning.
